

Terms of Participation
Of the
Clean Energy Design Thinking Challenge



General information

I. The event

1. The AEA / Institute for Production, Energy and Environmental Management ("Organizer") organizes the Clean Energy Design Thinking Challenge ("Event").
2. The Clean Energy Design Thinking Challenge 2017 is organized in co-operation with SAP and the Uni Management Club and will take place from 23 February 2017 to 26 February 2017 in Lakeside Park 2.0 in Klagenfurt am Wörthersee.

II. Liability of the organizer

1. Participation in the event, the evening program, the supporting program as well as the arrival and departure takes place at the participant's own risk.
2. In particular, the organizer's liability for damage caused by negligently is expressly excluded.
3. The organizer is not liable for the data and information provided by the speakers in the context of lectures or discussions or the participating companies within the framework of working groups or presentations.

III. Changes to the program

1. The organizer reserves the right to make any changes to the program. Possible claims of any form of the participants are expressly excluded.

3. The organizer reserves the right to cancel the event.

IV. Photo and video recordings

1. The participants give the organizer, as well as the companies participating in the event, the explicit consent to take photo and video footage at the event and to use it in online or print media, in particular for marketing and recruiting purposes, or to pass it on to third parties give.
2. The company participating in the event reserves the right to prohibit photo- and video recordings against the participants during the work in the working groups.

V. Results of the workshops

1. The participants give the organizer as well as the participating companies the express consent to use, modify or otherwise use the results obtained within the workshops at the event without restriction.
2. The data and information provided during the workshops as well as the results of the workshops may not be used without the consent of the respective companies. The participants have no rights to use the results of the workshops.

VI. Duties of the participants

1. The participants undertake to comply with the instructions of the organizer, their staff as well as the staff of the Lakeside Park 2.0, the accommodation and other service providers commissioned by the organizer.
2. In particular, information materials of all kinds submitted by the participants before or within the framework of the event must be followed. Non-compliance may result in exclusion from the event, subject to all other claims of the organizer.

VII. Cancellation and non-participation in the event

1. The written confirmation of the event invitation by the participants is regarded as the final promise of participation in the event.
2. If participation in a particular case is not possible despite a confirmed registration, this must be notified to the organizer immediately.

VIII. Registration for the participation and use of personal data and documents

1. Applications for participation in the event will be made via the online application tool on the website <http://kaernten.unimc.at/index.php/clean-energy-formular/>
2. The organizer collects and verifies all the data and documents submitted by the applicant (in particular CVs, certificates, documents, master data or answers to application questions, "application documents") and reserves the right to forward them to the companies participating in the event .
3. The applicants expressly agree to the internal use of the application documents, in particular their examination of completeness, by members of the organization team or UNIMC Carinthia.
4. Applicants expressly agree to the use of their application documents, in particular for recruiting and personnel marketing purposes, by the companies participating in the event.
5. In addition, the application documents of the applicants are not passed on to third parties by the organizer. Any further use or transfer of the application documents by the companies participating in the event cannot be influenced by the organizer.
6. The application documents are stored for technical reasons even before sending the complete application on the organizer's servers.

IX. Jurisdiction & applicable law

1. The exclusive court of jurisdiction shall be the competent court in Klagenfurt.
2. Only Austrian substantive law, with the exception of the United Nations Convention on Contracts for the International Sale of Goods and non-compulsory references, shall be deemed to have been agreed upon.

X. Severability clause

1. If one or more clauses of these General Terms and Conditions should be invalid in whole or in part, it is expressly agreed that the provisions which come closest to the intended purpose of the partially or completely invalid clause are applied.
2. Entire or partially invalid clauses shall not affect the existence or validity of the other validly agreed clauses.
